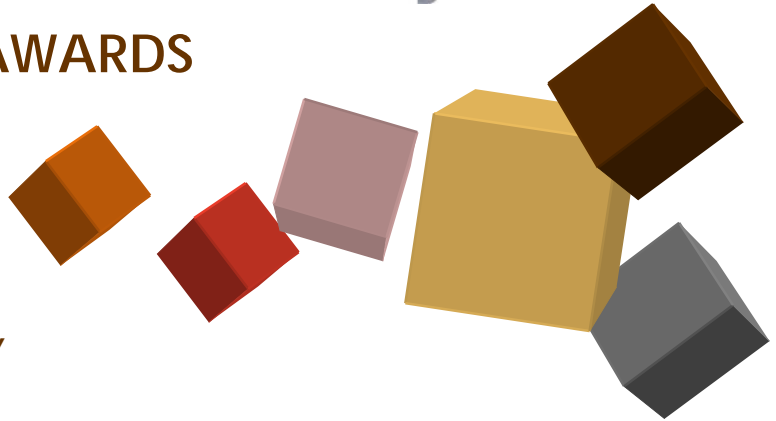

FALL 2015 DESIGN AWARDS



REQUIRED CONTENTS OF EACH ENTRY

SUBMITTAL FORMAT

Provide all necessary submittals on one Windows-compatible CD. The CD shall contain a PowerPoint file and a folder or Zip file containing up to five separate JPEG images.

POWERPOINT FILE

No Firm/Individual identification shall be visible anywhere within the PowerPoint file. The PowerPoint, which is to be no greater than 15MB in file size, shall contain a minimum of 5 (and a maximum of 12) image slides, including a minimum of 4 exterior and one interior views. Each slide should contain a separate image. Additional slides shall contain key project drawings and information as described below:

Project Description

- Explain fully the original design intentions and the distinguishing factors of the work on a single PowerPoint slide. Minimum font size of 10 pt.

Exterior Views

- Images showing each of the exposed sides of the building. Label with façade orientation.
- One additional image showing the context of each exposed side of the building (may be omitted if the project's relationship to its context is defined clearly in other images)
- For a group of buildings, one image of the project sufficient to illustrate the complete project, including its relationship to its environs. For projects involving exterior alterations, one image of each altered (exposed) side together with one image of the same side before alteration (unless evidence is submitted on the unavailability of the latter).

Interior

- A minimum of one full color image.

Drawings

- Include a graphic scale on all drawing slides
- Provide a site plan or aerial photograph showing the project and its context.
- Provide a floor plan or plans, and one or more sections sufficient to explain the solution

JPEG IMAGES

The folder or zip file may contain up to five separate JPEG images at resolution suitable for clear projection at 1080p, but no larger than 5 Megabytes. These images should contain the firm's name and logo, as they will not be used as part of the juried entry. The AIAVC retains the images for its collection and use and submission shall be considered license for use by AIAVC.
